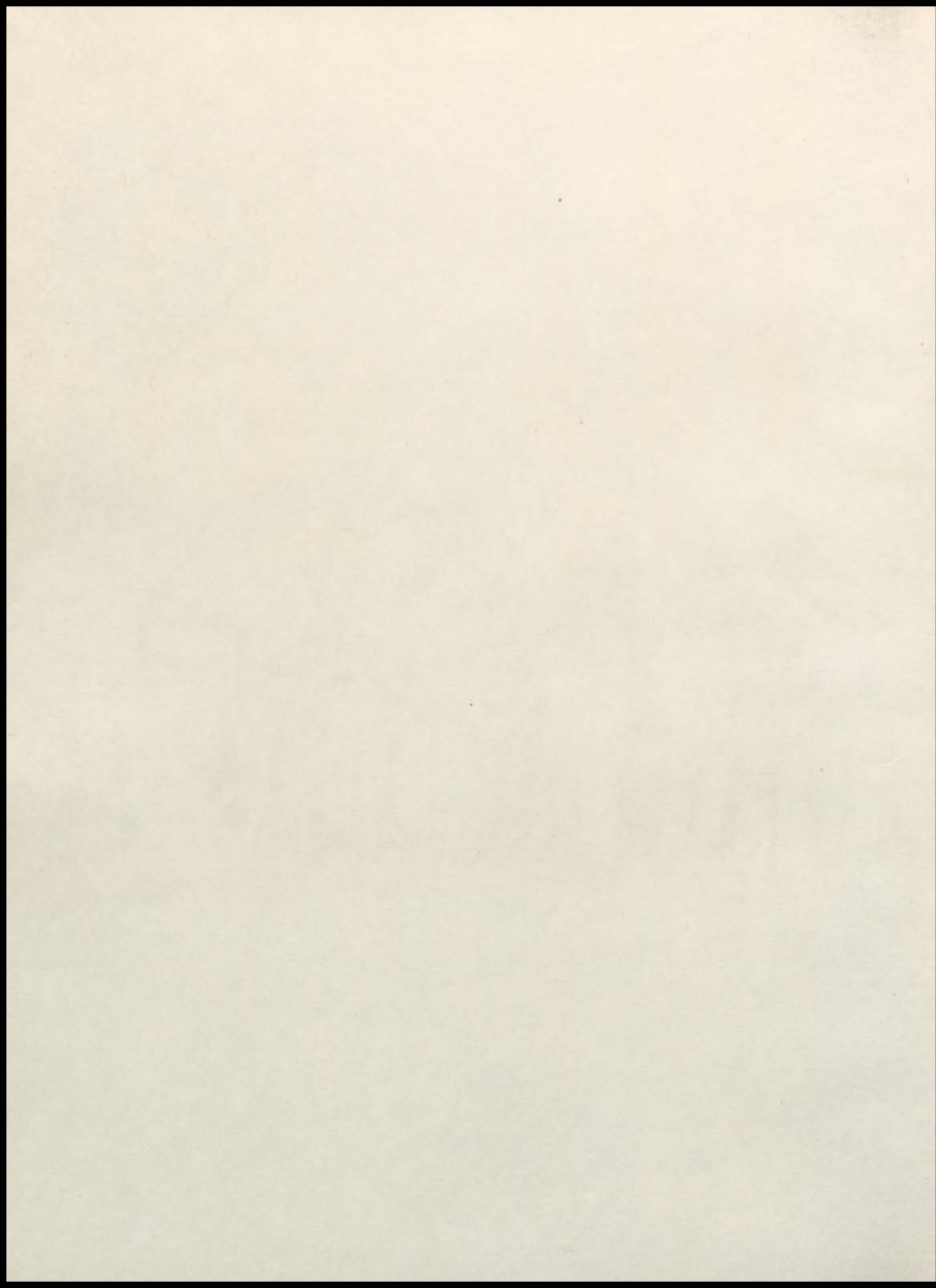

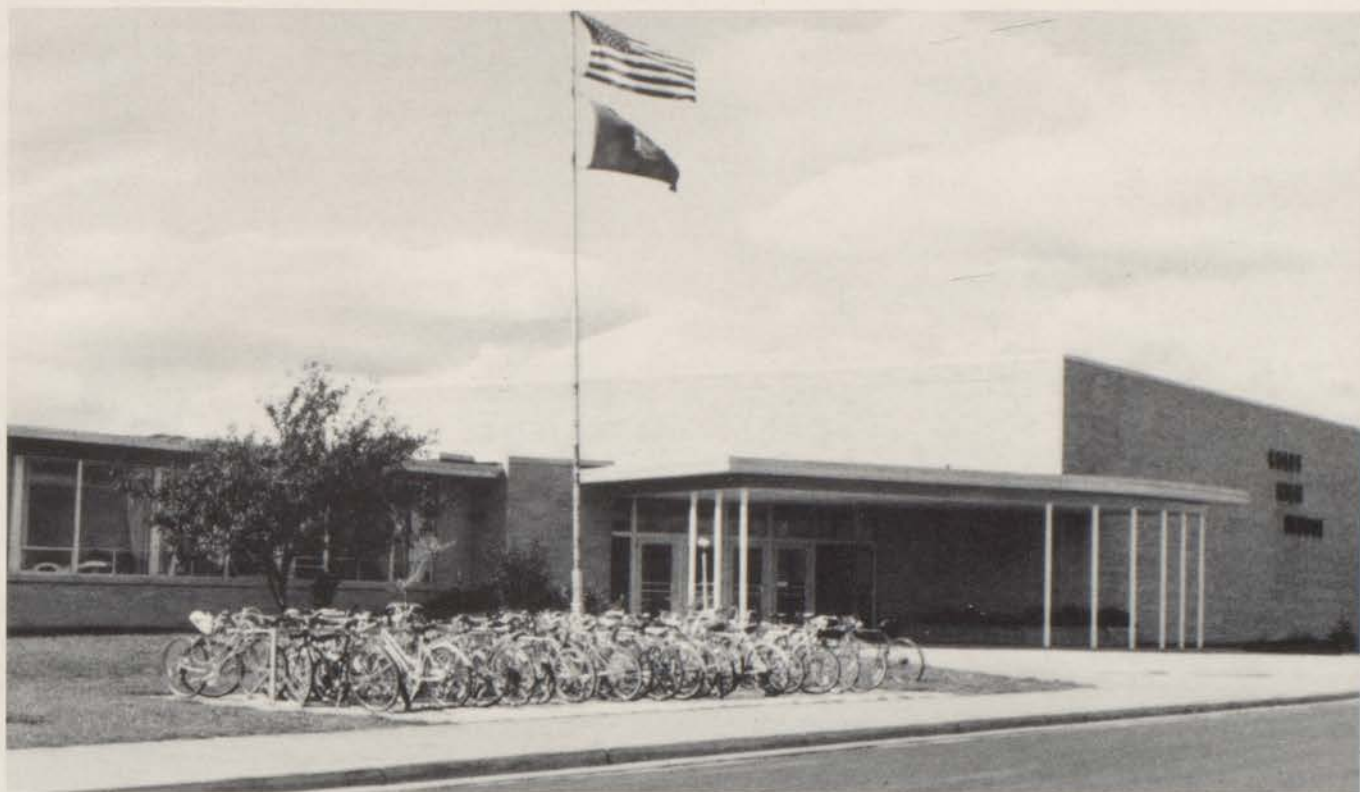

So much that you should know.

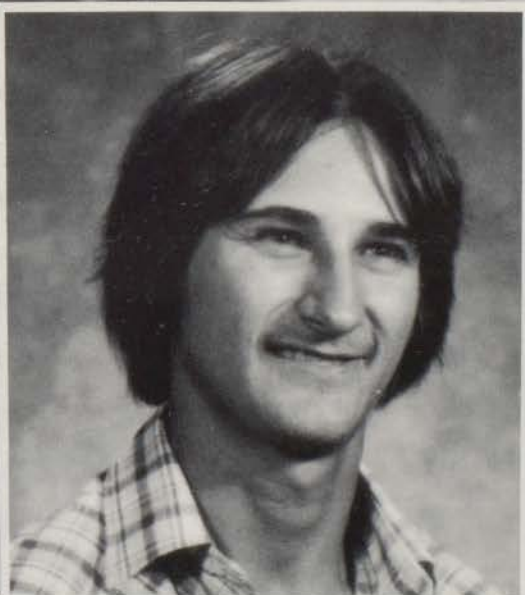
You lightened up our darkness,

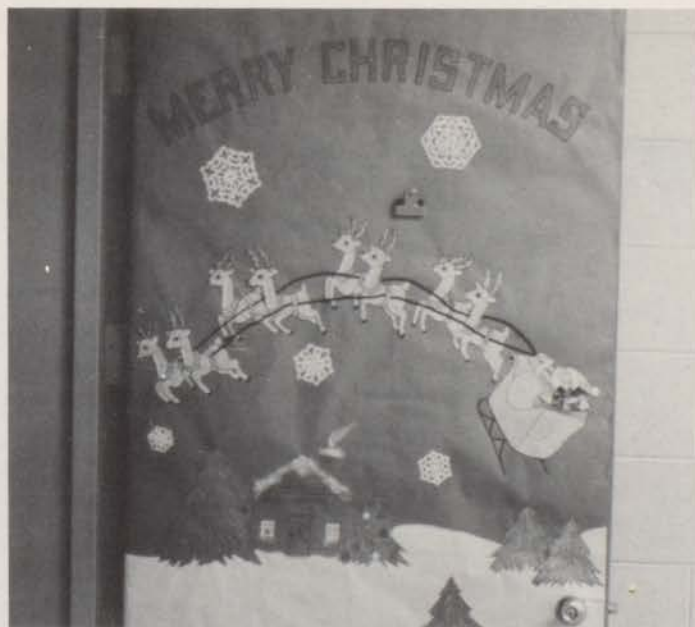

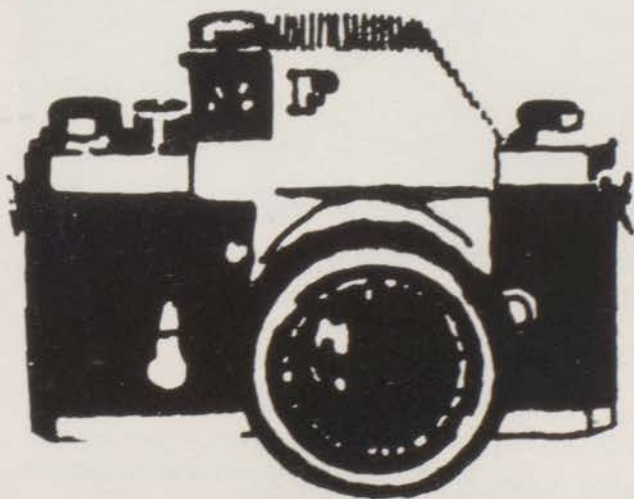
