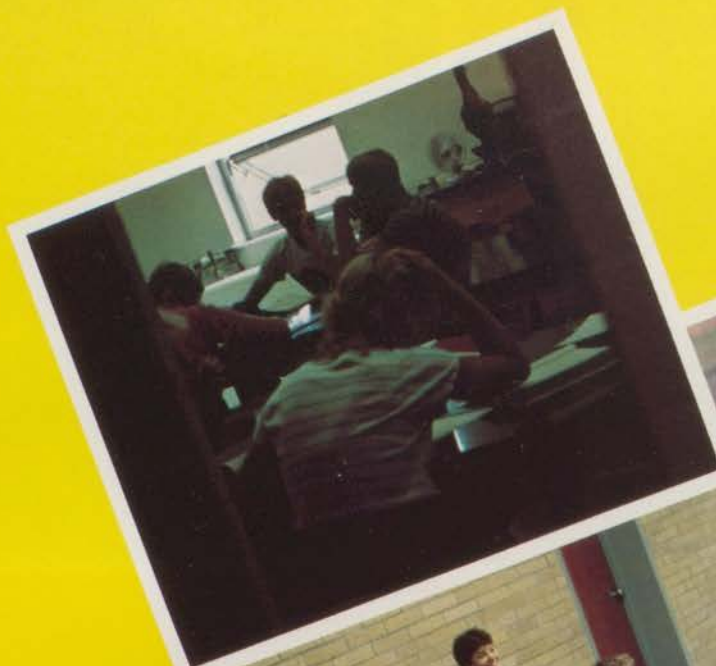

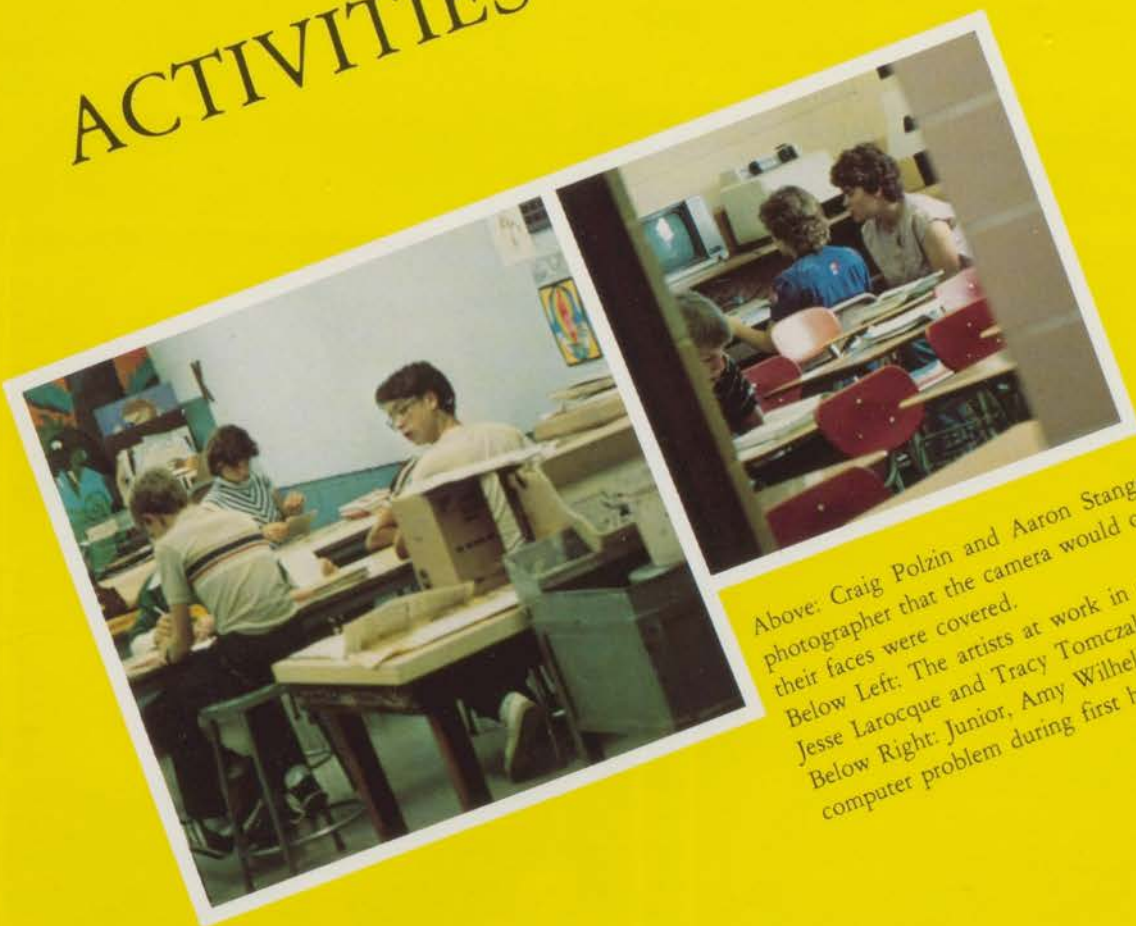

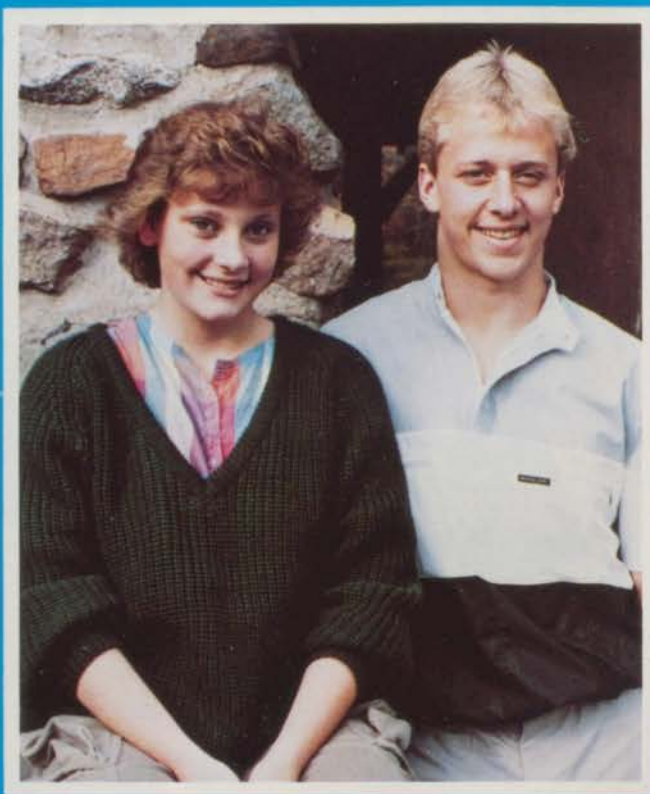

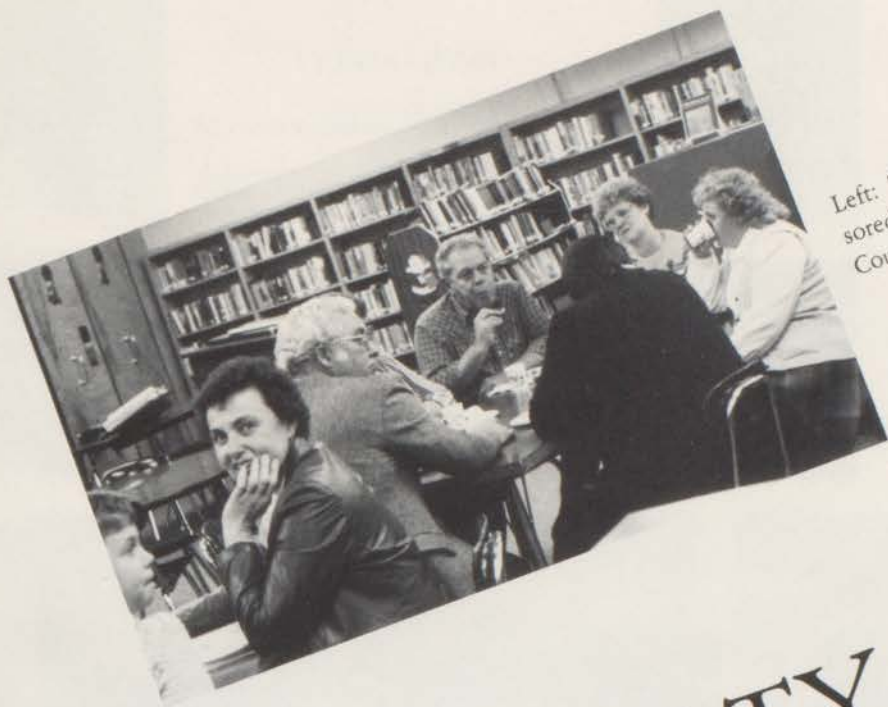

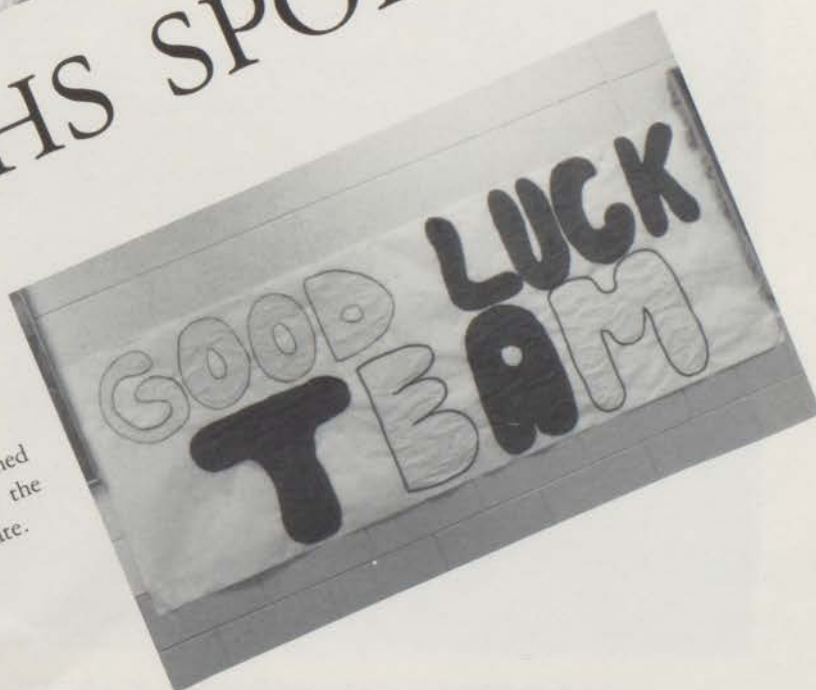

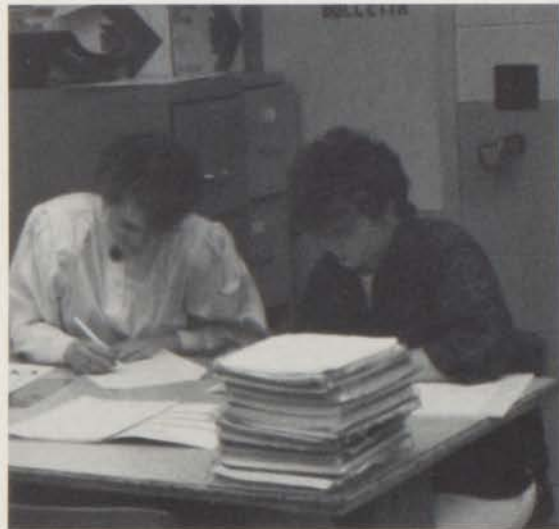

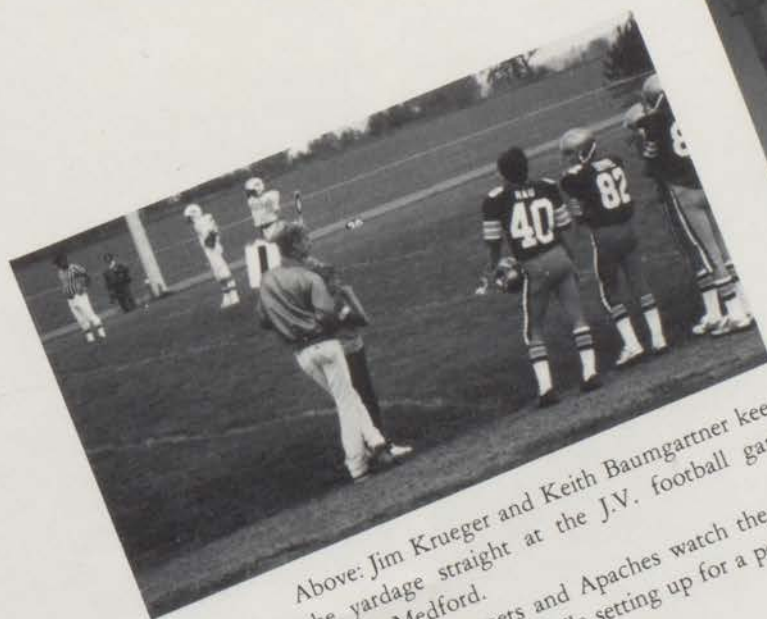

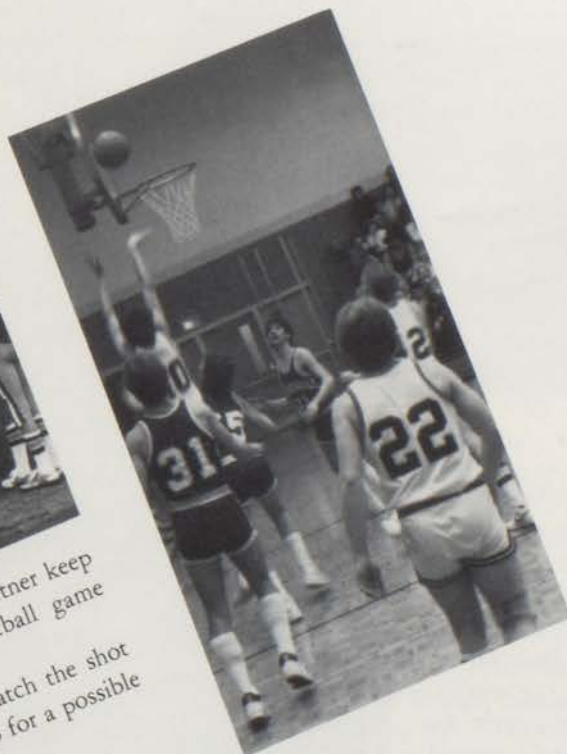


The runners take off as the gun sounds to start the Colby Cross Country Invitational.
