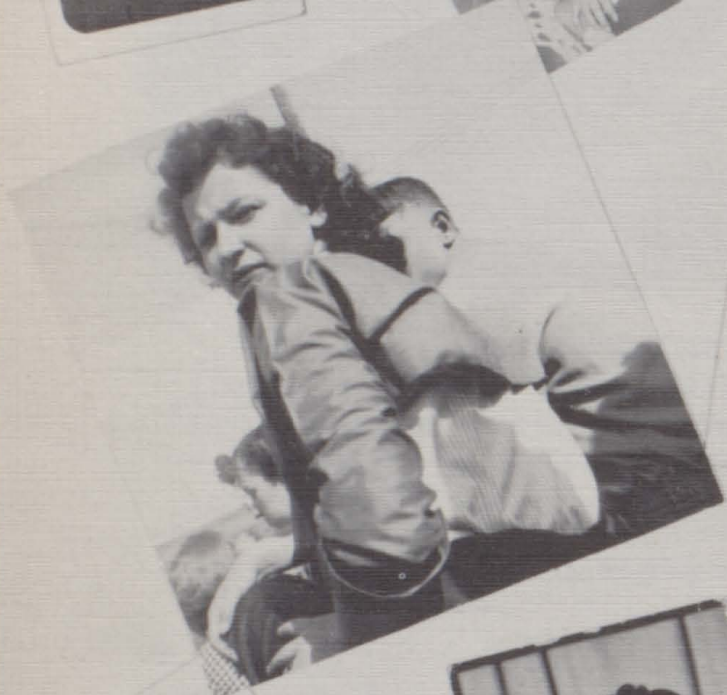
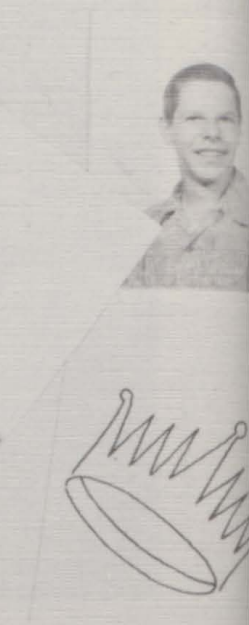
The sophomore class consists of 78 students being active in the line of school entertainment.
