Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I will ... dwell in the house of the Lord forever.



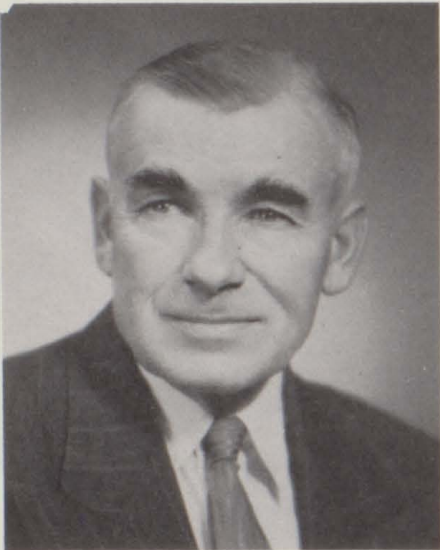

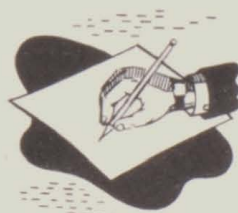


Hornet's Buzz
